Let us check our home for something very special...






Miss I, Mr. O and Mr. U want to see that can you find objects related to their vowel sounds in your home?

Quickly move and try to find 5 things in your home that have the vowel sound i, o and u








Its time to rock the floor on the beats of opposite words.









